The Skating Club of Biasca invite your teams to participate at the Biasca Trophy 2021, Synchronized Skating Competition, all categories, with the agreement of Swiss Ice Skating.

The competition will be conducted in accordance with the rules of the ISU and is opened to all eligible Team Skaters according to ISU Rule 102.

Place: Pista di Ghiaccio, 6710 Biasca (Ticino), Switzerland

Supported by Swiss Ice Skating

Technical regulations and conditions: The Biasca-Trophy 2021 will be held according to the ISU General Regulations 2018, the ISU Special Regulations & Technical Rules Synchronized Skating 2018 as well as the SYS Guidelines 2020-21 of Swiss Ice Skating

Important: The organiser advises the teams of the Non-ISU categories to refer to the special and updated Technical Guidelines for Competitions in Switzerland 2020/2021).

Teams, which have participated in the ongoing season in a certain category, are not allowed to take part in another category at the Biasca Trophy.

Judging system

The competition will be judged with the ISU Judging System.

Categories:

Seniors	short program and free skating
Juniors	short program and free skating
Advanced Novice	free skating
Basic Novice	free skating
Juvenile	free skating
Mixed Age	free skating
Senior B	free skating
Adults	free skating

Music:

All teams are requested to provide their competition music in advance by emailing an MP3-file to the following email-address: info@biascaskating.ch. Teams must send their music not later than 01 December 2020 (Form 3).

Each email message should only contain one music file. The subject of the email and the name of the file should be in the format "MUSIC" with the addition of the name of the team (for example MUSIC – Team ABC.mp3).

Upon accreditation all teams shall bring their competition music of excellent quality on CD (no mp3cd) as a backup. The CD must be properly inserted in its original case, must clearly show the name of the team as well as the exact running time of the music (not skating time). Only one program in one track per CD is permitted.

Registration:

Participating teams and Officials are invited to register upon arrival. A welcome desk will be in place at the Ice Rink, during all the time of the competition:

Saturday January 16, 2021, from 8h00 to 17h00

Sunday January 17, 2021, from 8h00 to 12h00

Deadline:

Entrance fees are non-refundable.

Judges:

Each participating ISU-Member entering at least 2 teams may enter one (1) International Judge or ISU-Judge for Synchronized Skating from the official ISU list of judges for the current season. National Championship Judges may also be entered.

For Judges of other ISU-Members than Switzerland the organiser will cover board and lodging from Friday evening January, 15 to Sunday evening January 17, 2021. All other expenses shall be the responsibility of each official or the entering association or club.

Judges Meeting:

The first judges meeting will take place Saturday, January 16, 2021 at around 12h00 at the Ice Rink. The Round table discussion will be held on Sunday, January 17, 2021 after the competition at the Ice Rink.

Official Practice:

The official practice begins on Saturday, January 16, 2021. Each team has 10 minutes official practice on ice for the short program and 12 minutes, or 10 minutes (for Novice Basic, Juvenile and Adult), for the free skating program.

On January 16 / 17 the ice is reserved for the official practice only.

The official practices are compulsory.

Additional Practice Ice is available on Friday, January 15, 2021, from 15h00 – 22h00 for Swiss Francs 50.— per 15 minutes.
